Treatment in New Hampshire

Led by New Future's Director of Closing the Addiction Treatment Gap (CATG). This session will provide a brief primer on the nature of addiction and an explanation of what treatment is. In addition, partners will learn about barriers to accessing treatment in NH and advocacy work being done to alleviate the situation. New Hampshire's CATG, funded by the Open Society Institute and the NH Charitable Foundation, intends to close the "gap" between those who need addiction treatment in New Hampshire and those few who receive it.
